Dear Reciprocal Club Flag Officers and Club Members,

On behalf of the Directors and Members of the Stormont Yacht Club, it is my pleasure to extend to you an invitation to visit our club and make use of our facilities during the 2022 sailing season.

The Stormont Yacht Club is located within sight of green buoy SX7, Chart 1433, just east of the village of Long Sault. Coordinates immediately off our front dock are 45° 01.60'N and 074° 52.97'W. Although the average depth in the bay outside of SYC is 10 to 20 feet, the average depth from seaward, including 50 feet on either side of our finger dock, is nominally 6 feet (subject to the chart datum reference). "Straight-in" approaches to either of our berthing bays provide a 5-foot depth. Depths inside the mooring bays are nominally a minimum 5 feet as well (subject to the current chart datum reference).

Our clubhouse offers our guests showers, full kitchen facilities, barbecues, ice, a screened-in porch, lawns and shade trees under which to relax and watch the world sail by.

Vessels of no more than 37 feet in length and 12 feet in beam, with a maximum 5-foot draught, are welcome at the visitor's dock located on the east dock of the entrance to the east bay. Guests may stay there for the duration of their stay or use empty berths in either of the two bays (subject to confirmation by the Duty Officer or an SYC member). A list of empty berths is located on a whiteboard in the clubhouse. Alternatively, guests may elect to moor off-shore on available moorings – again, subject to the Duty Officer's direction.

Our rate for reciprocating clubs is free for the first two nights and \$20 for each subsequent night, up to a maximum of four nights. Pump out and mast crane use is complementary.

We want you to feel welcome at the Stormont Yacht Club, so do not hesitate to join in our activities. During the week, members are usually on the grounds. On weekends, a Duty Officer is present between 10 a.m. and sunset. You can moor temporarily alongside the main dock (if there is room) and check-in at the clubhouse. Overnight stay is not permitted at the main dock due to high winds. Alternatively, if no members are around, you can moor at the visitor's dock (in the east bay) and check-in at the clubhouse the next morning. In either case, please be sure to complete a visitor registration form.

We hope you and your members will visit us this season.
